

2019 OSC Scholarship Application Requirements:

Print off application.

Fill it out in its entirety.

Use separate sheet for essay.

A minimum of 2 Letters of Recommendation must be directly emailed by the person writing the letter to ozarksoccerclub@gmail.com. They must put your name in the subject line. A reply will be sent to the person writing the letter and to the scholarship applicant to confirm that we have received the letter.

All paperwork must be received by March 31, 2018 @5pm

All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the OSC Board and then submitted to an outside review committee to decide the winners if necessary. OSC Coaches may be contacted to verify information.

Application and essay must be scanned and emailed together to ozarksoccerclub@gmail.com no later than March 31, 2018 5pm to be eligible. A reply email will be sent to the applicant once it has been received. Please be sure to email the application from a non-school address as we are not able to reply back to student school addresses.

Applicants will be reviewed on the following:

- o Commitment to Ozark Soccer Club
- o Recommendations (2)
- o OSC and OHS Coaches assessment of character, discipline and leadership
- o Attendance to practices and games

**Money has been set aside for one male and one female to receive a \$500 scholarship for college. Money issued to student will be sent directly to the school they are attending by Sept 1 of that year. Money can be used for books, tuition or room/board. Criteria for the scholarship is listed, but not limited to: Must have played Club ball for OSC. Must be attending a 2 or 4 year college the following Fall. Must have maintained a 2.5 GPA while in high school. Priority will be given to those who were the most active with OSC and who represented the program with character. If there are no recipients that hold the criteria necessary in the current graduating class, there may be the option for OSC to give the scholarship to someone who has met criteria, but is of another gender. (2 male scholarships or 2 female scholarships), but also have the right to not award any scholarships.
